

## FEAST OF THE ASSUMPTION OF MARY



On November 1, 1950 Pope Pius XII declared the dogma of the Assumption of Mary proclaiming that the Virgin Mary, *“having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory”* (Munificentissimus Deus, the Papal Bull defining the dogma).

In the United States this feast is celebrated as a holy day of obligation on August 15th. As we contemplate Mary being taken to heaven we reflect on our destiny to follow her into heavenly glory. We encourage everyone to celebrate this feast day by joining the community at the table of the Eucharist, the foretaste and promise of the heavenly banquet God has prepared for each of us.
